Minutes of the Casitas Municipal Water District Board Meeting Held February 12, 2014

A meeting of the Board of Directors was held February 12, 2014 at Casitas' Office, Oak View, California. Directors Hicks, Bergen, Kaiser, Baggerly and Word were present. Also present were Steve Wickstrum, General Manager, Rebekah Vieira, Clerk of the Board, and Attorney, John Mathews. There were three staff members and three members of the public in attendance. President Hicks led the group in the flag salute.

1. <u>Public Comments</u> (items not on the agenda – three minute limit).

Mike Tracy, a resident of Ventura and Ventura City Council member informed the board that he had been appointed to represent the City Council with Casitas.

2. General Manager comments.

Mr. Wickstrum informed the board that he would be at jury duty next Tuesday. He then asked if the board had seen the conservation banners at the front of the building. The newsletters are being delivered to the mail house tomorrow and will then be sent out.

On January 31, 2014 State Water came out with a zero allocation for the first time in the 54 years of the project. Discussions were held on Tuesday regarding the condition of the state water project and the indecision on how to redistribute what water is available. They want to make sure they are serving the minimum health and safety but there are concerns on agriculture that relies on state water in the central valley.

The most recent rainfall did very little in curbing the drought in Northern California. Lake Orville is in pretty bad shape. Folsom came up about ten feet but it is not enough to get above the 1977 drought trend. This is a large issue. Last Friday Congresswoman Julia Brownley brought entities and the general managers of area water districts and flood control district together to obtain insight for herself as she returns to Washington. She is looking for anything where she can help at the federal level.

I attended the Board of Supervisors meeting yesterday afternoon. There was a very good presentation including Fire Prevention, GSA and the Water Works districts that the county represents. Steve Bennett asked for consideration of turf areas surrounding the Government Center. It was good to hear that the county is participating in reducing their water demands. There is a lot going on right now, and the drought is on everyone's radar. Everyone is participating with Governor Brown's move to declare a water shortage emergency.

Discussions are continuing with Ojai Valley Inn. There is a potential for them to see how they can reduce the amount of water they use and see how to

irrigate their turf in a shorter amount of time. There may be a consideration of assistance regarding water with something to bring further to the board at a future date. This might be a good use of the capital facilities charge.

I have a meeting this Friday with the Department of Health Services in Carpinteria to discuss options to continue our agreement on the delivery of water to Rincon Point.

If there is interest by the board to see the progress at Villanova reservoir, I would prefer you contacting me and we can take you up there.

3. <u>Board of Director comments.</u>

Director Word mentioned a pine tree that needs removal. Director Kaiser asked about the ground squirrel population and Director Bergen mentioned that she had heard that Cal Trans will begin looking at their irrigation practices in light of the drought. Director Baggerly asked if there was any progress on the sound issue at Reeves Road. Mr. Wickstrum informed the board that the first installation did not produce the desired results and we are waiting for product that is shipping from Minnesota on March 10th. President Hicks mentioned a temporary hook up being used by Granite Construction that is leaking.

President Hicks, on behalf of the Board, presented a thank you to Mr. Wickstrum for his 30 years of service to Casitas.

Mr. Wickstrum explained that there are issues with the Cortez as it is too large for our needs and it is difficult to maneuver or pull someone out of the water. The Cortez will be provided back to the state.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board of Directors authorize the General Manager to approve Change Order No. 6 for the Villanova Reservoir Repair and Interior Coating in the not-to-exceed amount of \$44,000 to coat the exterior of the reservoir.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION:

Casitas Board of Directors awarded the contract to repair and coat the interior of the Villanova Reservoir on September 25, 2013 in the amount of \$656,650.00. The project included repairing the Villanova Reservoir structure and coating the interior of the reservoir. The Board of Directors also authorized the General Manager to approve up to \$100,000 in change orders and quantity increases. To date, five change orders have been approved along with quantity increases for rafters, brackets and welding time. Additional quantity increases are being negotiated. Below is a summary of the change orders and quantity increases

The contractor has proposed an additional change order to coat the exterior of the reservoir at a cost not-to-exceed \$44,000. Staff believe this is a very reasonable cost for this work. The 10 year capital budget did propose to complete the exterior coating in 2018-19 Fiscal Year. The FY 2013-14 Budget allocated \$1,035,000 for the completion of this project. The total cost for the project with the proposed Change Order No. 6 and the maximum quantity increases will be \$779,662. This is still about 25% below budget.

BACKGROUND AND OVERVIEW:

1. Roll Call.

Director Mary Bergen and Director Jim Word General Manager Steve Wickstrum Accounting Manager and Treasurer Denise Collin Public: Mr. Robert Baskin

2. **Public comments**. None.

3. **Board/Management comments**.

The General Manager brought to the Committee a request to consider a change order to paint the entire exterior of the Villanova Reservoir. Staff has received a tentative price of \$44,000 to perform the work. The cost of the project would still remain under the budget cost estimate. The change order would exceed the General Manager's cost authority, therefore the Committee concurred that this change order be considered by the Board of Directors on February 26, 2014.

The General Manager informed the Committee of costs that are likely to be incurred to re-stage pump(s) at Ventura Avenue No. 1 Pump Plant and Rincon Pump Plant, as a result of the declining lake levels during the summer.

4. Review of the request from Robert Baskin for high usage.

This is a follow up item from the January 26 Finance Committee meeting. Denise Collin reported on information that had been gathered since the last Financial Committee meeting regarding Mr. Baskin's water usage during November 2013. The information reported described the testing of the meter serving Mr. Baskin's property, and indicated that the meter is operating within acceptable standards and there are no apparent defects to the meter parts. Mr. Baskin had reported to Denise Collin that he had talked to Mr. White, owner of a neighboring agricultural parcel, and that according to Mr. White there is no interconnection between the two private systems that may have resulted in such a large water use in November 2013. Denise Collin also noted that Mr. Baskin had a leak in 2010 that Casitas staff had assisted him in finding, and that there was not a large loss of water during the 2010 water leak. Mr. Baskin assured the Committee that there was no water leak in November 2013 and that the irrigation system had been turned off for two weeks of November 2013.

The Committee suggested that this case be considered by the Board of Directors, during a regular meeting of March 2014 during which Mr. Baskin can plan to attend. Mr. Baskin will call staff with information on which Board meeting he can attend. The General Manager will also seek counsel's advise on any legal issues that may arise in consideration of Mr. Baskin's request for water billing relief.

5. Review of the Finance Statement for January 2014.

The Committee reviewed the expenditures in various work sections of the District. Denise Collin noted that the district has received additional funding in miscellaneous account from the dissolution of the Redevelopment Agency, higher than budgeted revenue. The Committee reviewed and noted several revenue trends in the recreation accounts.

6. Review of the Water Consumption for January 2014.

The Committee reviewed the water consumption numbers for January 2014. The upward trending water demands by the Agricultural classification is indicative of the dry weather pattern and depleted groundwater basins, transferring the demand to the Lake Casitas supply. There was a notable decline in the Resale classification from previous months.
