Minutes of the Casitas Municipal Water District Board Meeting Held September 26, 2012

A special meeting of the Board of Directors was held September 26, 2012 at Casitas' Office, Oak View, California. Directors Baggerly, Hicks, Bergen and Kaiser were present. Director Word was absent. Also present were Steve Wickstrum, General Manager, Rebekah Vieira, Clerk of the Board, and Attorney, John Mathews. There was one staff member and no members of the public in attendance. President Baggerly led the group in the flag salute.

1. <u>Public Comments</u>

2. <u>General Manager comments</u>.

Mr. Wickstrum reported on the favorable performance of Casitas Staff, The City of Ventura and communities that conserved water during our shutdown. We took care of something that needed to be taken care of and didn't discharge a drop of water into the environment. Staff were prepared and we were back on line by 8 p.m. Everyone contributed well. We had water buffalos out and we assisted the Girl Scouts with additional CT's once we learned they had three hundred girls at the camp. I am very proud of the way the staff put the plan together. President Baggerly expressed the Board's thanks to all staff. Director Kaiser added we were proactive and there was great communication with the board members. It was a job well done by everyone.

Mr. Wickstrum informed the board that arguments will be heard in the appeals court on November 6th and he would like to be in attendance. The board concurred.

Mr. Wickstrum then mentioned an article that had been in the Ventura County Star regarding the City of Ventura developing a water rights ordinance. John Mathews will take a look at it and report back.

3. <u>Board of Director comments</u>.

Director Bergen requested adding information on expenditures for Ojai Flow to the monthly board report so that it is easily accessible. Mr. Wickstrum suggested having it as a separate report.

Director Kaiser mentioned the regional cross country meet that was held at Lake Casitas. Staff did a great job making sure things went smoothly. It was impressive and amazing to see how well everyone worked together. It is a wellrecognized course in California. Mr. Wickstrum informed the board that there was one heat incident and a sprained ankle.

On the motion of Director Kaiser, seconded by Director Bergen and passed, the above recommendation was approved.

9. <u>Recommend approval of revisions to the Business Ordinance to include a</u> policy on the use of credit cards. ADOPTED

Mr. Wickstrum explained Director Kaiser had some good comments and we added in the penalties under Government Code 8314 which addresses the misuse of public resources.

Director Kaiser asked how many cards. Mr. Wickstrum responded there are two. The cardholders are myself and Rebekah. The district also has store charge cards for Sears and Home Depot. Director Kaiser asked that language be modified to include the penal code.

President Baggerly suggested updating the Rules of Conduct as it states the district only has one credit card.

The ordinance with requested modification was offered by Director Kaiser, seconded by Director Bergen and adopted by the following roll call vote:

10. <u>Discussion regarding the State Regional Water Quality Control Board</u> <u>Ventura River TMDL</u>.

President Baggerly reported that the regional board is pushing the idea of an MOU for responsible parties in the upper Ventura watershed and reach four of the river. The MOU would be in lieu of a TMDL. Scientific studies need to be done to determine the effect on steelhead trout. We have already done that for Robles. Groundwater pumpers are being dragged into this. Shirley is pushing the idea of signing a MOU with undetermined measurable goals with trying to maintain certain pools for steelhead. The pool they are looking at is the one on the Land Conservancy property that dries up every year no matter what. Once connectivity is lost it is a dry stretch of river and always has been. People are nervous to sign a document that could be problematic. Cindy with EPA says if there is no agreement in a month and half they will do a TMDL for impairments in Ventura River with linkages to causation to the amount of water taken out of the river. I don't see how they can scientifically do that. Director Bergen added their staff report says they don't have anything. She then asked if we are considered a responsible party and how are they deciding that. This is a dry flow and we are under our Biologic Opinion and they are talking about dry up of the river after we stop diverting. Mr. Wickstrum added they link surface water diversions to water that would otherwise be available. The other impact is well users on the river.

President Baggerly added a letter was sent to Shirley to delist reach 4 based on fact they have no information other than 1996 steelhead recovery plan by DFG. In that study they asked for things that have been done. Fish passage, BO, removal of Matilija Dam. She said no, we want a TMDL. Mr. Wickstrum added I have issues signing on a MOA and agreeing to do something that may not be solvable.

John Mathews cautioned the board that there is a deadline and they will meet the deadline. It is not based on good science but is based on lawyers. They are rushing it based on legal deadlines. That is not good. Mr. Wickstrum added the problem with drafting the TMDL is their deadline of March, 2013 and what science do they have? It was suggested to try to develop a good MOU and to involve Bob Krimmer in the meetings.

Director Bergen asked to clarify the mileage amount in the terms of cents per mile. President Baggerly pointed out the number 2 on page nine that should be removed.

PSM Belser reported that the 2012 Bowfishing for Carp season opens today. She stated that the season will end December 31, 2012 and then the season will run annually with each calendar year, beginning January 1, 2013. Belser also informed the Committee of the continued positive working relations the District has with the Department of Fish and Game and the Bureau of Reclamation regarding various issues related to the Recreation Area.

4. 2012 Night Fishing Tournaments Awarded to Western Outdoor News.

PSM Belser reviewed the bid process for exclusive night fishing tournaments. Western Outdoor News (Rich Tauber) submitted the most appealing bid to Casitas. He offered \$56 per boat with a 20 boat minimum. Belser reviewed that participants are subject to all invasive species inspections, cabling and tagging protocol as other lake customers. The Committee supported the bid and forwarded it to the Board for their consideration and approval.

5. September 2012 Fee Comparison Survey Results.

PSM Belser handed out a 2012 user fee study conducted by PSO Doan. The Committee felt the fees are in line with other lakes in the Southern California Area and did not recommend changes or increases at this time.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the Board of Directors approve the purchase of live rainbow trout for a total amount of \$34,198.25 from Chaulk Mound Trout Ranch in Nebraska.

BACKGROUND:

The purchase of live rainbow trout, required to be supplied by distributors approved by the California Department of Fish and Game (DFG), was authorized by Edmund Pert, a DFG representative. Bids were solicited from seven suppliers located in California, Oregon and Nebraska. The total bid request was for \$34,205 made up as follows:

(a) Live rainbow trout between 3/4 to one (3/4 to 1) pounds per fish, the total cost of which was not to exceed twenty two thousand dollars (\$22,000).

(b) Live rainbow trout between two and twelve (2-12) pounds per fish, four (4) fish over ten (10) pounds and two (2) fish over twelve(12) pounds, the total cost of which was not to exceed eight thousand dollars (\$8,000).

(c) Live rainbow trout 1/2 pound per fish, the total cost of which was not to exceed four thousand two hundred and five dollar (\$4,205). These fish will be purchased with LCIF funds.

The lowest bid was from Chaulk Mound Trout Ranch in Nebraska for a total of \$34,198.25 which will include 9,832 pounds of live rainbow trout.

The bid submitted by Chaulk Mound Trout Ranch is attached. Chaulk Mound Trout Ranch has delivered quality fish to Casitas and has met our quagga inspection and pathogen free protocol over the past two years.

BACKGROUND:

Lake Casitas Recreation Area submitted bid requests for exclusive rights to organize night fishing tournaments in 2013 with the payments being made to the Lake Casitas Improvement Foundation (LCIF).

Bids were solicited from nine (9) organizations, with two (2) bids received. Western Outdoor News Bass was the highest responsible bidder with a bid of \$56 per team. American Bass Association submitted a bid of \$30 per team. The seven (7) organizations that did not submit bids were Stanton Marine, Eric's Tackle, Ventura County Bass Club, National Bass Tournaments, American Bass Association Tournaments, West Coast Christian Anglers and Casitas Bait and Tackle.

The bid of \$56 per team with a minimum payment of 20 boats will bring at least \$1,120 per tournament.

WON Bass has been hosting fishing tournaments at Lake Casitas for several years and should be able to fulfill the requirements in the bid specifications. Casitas boat inspection protocol is required to be followed for all teams participating in the tournaments.

The funds donated to the LCIF have been used to support special events such as Kids Fishing Day and the purchase of additional trout.

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into by and between CASITAS MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT, called herein "Casitas", and "WESTERN OUTDOOR NEWS BASS/WON BASS, called herein "Company".

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED as follows:

1. **Description**

(a) Casitas hereby grants to Company and its employees, agents, and volunteers permission to enter upon and use the property located at 11311 Santa Ana Road, Ventura, California 93001 (herein called "**Property**"), the specific location(s) being the lake and boat launch ramps, for the purpose of conducting Night Bass Fishing Tournaments, (herein called "**Tournament**") commencing on or about February 1, 2013 to and including December 1, 2013.

(b) While Casitas will make every effort to provide its facilities for Company, Casitas shall have no liability to Company if Casitas' facilities become restricted or closed for reasons including, but not limited to, acts of God, terrorism, war or the inability to provide facilities if permitting agencies revoke permits or authorization to use facilities.

(c) Company is hereby given exclusive rights to operate a maximum of five (5) Tournaments. referenced in (a) above. The tournaments are subject to the scheduling of Casitas, and may be changed by mutual agreement between both parties due to unfavorable weather conditions.

(d) Company agrees to use reasonable care to prevent damage to the Property, and will indemnify Casitas, and all other parties lawfully in possession of the Property, and hold each of them harmless from any claims and demands of any person or persons arising out of or based upon personal injuries, death or property damage suffered by such person or persons resulting directly from any act of negligence on Company's part in connection with its activities herein described.

(e) Company shall have the right to photograph, record and use in any manner whatsoever any name connected with the Property and any signs located thereon and rely on any logos and verbiage contained on such signs in connection with, or as part of, the Tournaments. Company shall have the right to reproduce, exhibit, advertise and exploit all of the photographs and recordings made in connection with the Tournaments in any and all media, whether now known or hereafter devised, throughout the universe in perpetuity. Company shall be the sole owner of all right, title and interest in and to the Tournament and any photographs and recordings hereunder, and neither Casitas nor any other party, now or hereafter having an interest in the Property, shall have any right of action against Company or any other party arising out of any use of said photographs and/or sound recordings, whether or not such use is, or may be claimed to be defamatory, untrue or censorable in nature.

(f) Participants in the Tournaments shall pay fees for vehicles and boats at the entrance gate unless annual permits are displayed. Day use, overnight and camping fees shall be charged as applicable.

(g) All boats on the water must keep night navigational lights on at all times. Participants must wear life preservers with kill switch attached any time the large engine is running. No drugs or alcohol are allowed. Maximum speed limit during the Tournaments will be 5 MPH unless otherwise authorized by Casitas.

(h) All participants' vehicles with or without a boat trailer must have one bright colored ribbon hanging from the rear view mirror. Another ribbon must be attached to the stern light of the boat.

(i) Tournament hours, including pre and post activities, will be agreed in writing with Casitas prior to each Tournament.

(j) A copy of a California Department of Fish and Game Fishing Tournament Permit must be provided to Casitas at least seven (7) days prior to each tournament.

(k) All boats shall be subject to inspection for invasive species and be in compliance with Casitas' Tamper Proof Tag Program and quarantine process. Any deviation from this process/inspection shall result in eviction from the Tournament and the Lake Casitas Recreation Area.

2. **Fees**

Fees will be paid pursuant to the bid submitted by Company dated September 20, 2012. A payment will be made to the Lake Casitas Improvement Foundation in the amount of fifty six dollars (\$56) per boat, per Tournament, within ten (10) days after each Tournament.

3. Commercial General Liability For Tournament

(a) <u>Coverage</u>. Coverage for commercial general liability shall be at least as broad as the following:

- (1) Insurance Services Office Commercial General Liability Coverage (Occurrence Form CG 0001).
- (2) Insurance Services Office Liquor Liability Coverage (Occurrence Form CG 0033).

(b) <u>Limits</u>. Company shall, during the course of this Project, maintain limits no less than the following:

(1) <u>General Liability</u>. TWO MILLION DOLLARS (\$2,000,000) per occurrence for bodily injury, property damage and personal injury. If Commercial General Liability Insurance or other form with a general aggregate limit is used, either the general aggregate limit shall apply separately to the project/location (with the ISO CG 2503, or ISO CG 2504, or insurer's equivalent endorsement provided to Casitas) or the general aggregate limit shall be twice the required occurrence limit.

(c) <u>Required Provisions</u>. The general liability policy is to contain, or be endorsed to contain the following provisions:

- (1) The United States of America (Bureau of Reclamation), Casitas, its directors, officers, employees, or authorized volunteers shall be named as additional insured (via ISO endorsement CG 2026 or insurer's equivalent for general liability coverage) as respects: liability arising out of activities performed by or on behalf of the Company; products and completed operations of the Company; premises occupied or used by the Company. The coverage shall contain no special limitations on the scope of protection afforded to the Casitas, its directors, officers, employees, or authorized volunteers.
- (2) For any claims related to this Project, the Company's insurance shall state that coverage is primary as respects the United States of America (Bureau of Reclamation), Casitas, its directors, officers, employees, or authorized volunteers, and any insurance, self insurance, or other coverage obtained or maintained by Casitas, its directors, officers, employees, or authorized volunteers shall be in excess of said primary coverage and not contributing.
- (3) Any failure to comply with reporting or other provisions of the policies including breaches of warranties shall not affect coverage provided to the United States of America (Bureau of Reclamation), Casitas, its directors, officers, employees, or authorized volunteers.
- (4) The Company's insurance shall apply separately to the insured against whom claim is made or suit is brought, except with respect to the limits of the insurer's liability.
- (5) Each insurance policy required by this clause shall be endorsed to state that coverage shall not be canceled by either party, except after thirty (30) days (10 days for non-payment of premium) prior written notice by U.S. Mail has been given to Casitas.
- (6) Such liability insurance shall indemnify Company against loss from liability imposed by law upon, or assumed under contract by, Company for damages on account of such bodily injury (including death), property damage, and personal injury.
- (7) The general liability policy shall cover bodily injury and property damage liability, owned and non-owned equipment, and blanket contractual liability.

(d) <u>Deductibles and Self-Insured Retentions</u>. Any deductible or self-insured retention must be declared to and approved by Casitas. At the option of Casitas, the insurer shall either reduce or eliminate such deductibles or self-insured retentions.

(e) <u>Acceptability of Insurers</u>. All of the insurance shall be provided on policy forms and through companies satisfactory to Casitas. Insurance is to be placed with insurers having a current A.M. Best rating of no less than A-VII or equivalent or as otherwise approved by Casitas.

(f) <u>Workers' Compensation & Employer's Liability Insurance</u>. By signature on behalf of Company hereunder, the undersigned certifies that he/she is aware of the provisions of Section 3700 of the California Labor Code which require every employer to be insured against liability for workers' compensation or to undertake self-insurance in accordance with the provisions of that code, and he/she will comply with such provisions before commencing the Project. The Company shall cover or insure under the applicable laws relating to workers' compensation insurance, all of the employees working on the Project,

in accordance with the "Workers' Compensation and Insurance Act," Division IV of the Labor Code of the State of California and any Acts amendatory thereof. The Company shall provide employer's liability insurance in the amount of at least TWO MILLION DOLLARS (\$2,000,000) per accident for bodily injury and disease. In the event Workers' Compensation & Employer's Liability Insurance does not apply to Company, Company shall execute a California Workers' Compensation Law Certificate of Exemption.

(g) <u>Evidences of Insurance</u>. Prior to commencement of Project, Company shall file with Casitas a Certificate of Insurance (Acord Form 25-S or equivalent) signed by the insurer's representative. Such evidence shall include a copy of the additional insured endorsement signed by the insurer's representative. Such evidence shall also include confirmation that coverage includes or has been modified to include (c) Required Provisions (1) through (7) above.

(h) The Company shall, upon demand of Casitas, deliver to Casitas such policy or policies of insurance. Failure to provide the required insurance coverage will result in the loss of the use of the facility. Company shall provide increased limits of insurance if required of Casitas by Casitas' insurer at no cost or liability to Casitas.

4. Indemnification.

To the fullest extent permitted by law, Company shall indemnify and hold harmless and defend the United States of America (Bureau of Reclamation), Casitas, its directors, officers, employees, or authorized volunteers, and each of them from and against:

(a) Any and all claims, demands, causes of action, damages, costs, expenses, losses or liabilities, in law or in equity, of every kind and nature whatsoever, for, but not limited to, injury to or death of any person including the United States of America (Bureau of Reclamation), Casitas and/or Company, or any directors, officers, employees, or authorized volunteers of Casitas or Company, and damages to or destruction of property of any person, including but not limited to, the United States of America (Bureau of Reclamation), Casitas and/or Company and their directors, officers, employees, or authorized volunteers, arising out of or in any manner directly or indirectly connected with the Project to be performed under this Agreement, however caused, regardless of any negligence of the United States of America (Bureau of Reclamation), Casitas or its directors, officers, employees, or authorized volunteers.

(b) Any and all actions, proceedings, damages, costs, expenses, penalties or liabilities, in law or equity, of every kind or nature whatsoever, arising out of, resulting from or on account of the violation of any governmental law or regulation, compliance with which is the responsibility of Company.

(c) Any and all losses, expenses, damages (including damages to the work itself), and other costs, including all costs of defense, which any of them may incur with respect to the failure, neglect, or refusal of Company or to faithfully perform all of its obligations under the contract. Such costs, expenses, and damages shall include all costs incurred by the indemnified parties in any lawsuits to which they are a party.

(d) Company shall defend, at Company's own cost, expense and risk, any and all such aforesaid suits, actions or other legal proceedings of every kind that may be brought or instituted against Casitas or Casitas' directors, officers, employees, or authorized volunteers.

(e) Company shall pay and satisfy any judgment, award or decree that may be rendered against Casitas or its directors, officers, employees, or authorized volunteers, in any such suit, action or other legal proceeding.

(f) Company shall reimburse Casitas and its directors, officers, employees, or authorized volunteers, for any and all legal expenses and costs incurred by each of them in connection therewith or in enforcing the indemnity herein provided.

(g) Company agrees to carry insurance for this purpose as set out in the specifications. Company's obligation to indemnify shall not be restricted to insurance proceeds, if any, received by the United States of America (Bureau of Reclamation), Casitas, or its directors, officers, employees, or authorized volunteers.

5. **Permits and Notifications for Tournament.**

(a) Company shall notify and make all necessary arrangements, as applicable, with state and local public agencies, including, but not limited to, the Ventura County Sheriff's Office, California Highway Patrol, Ventura County Health Department and the County Fire Department. If applicable, fire permits shall include those necessary for public use of a large tent, use of explosives or pyrotechnics and blank ammunition.

(b) In the event any state or local public agency does not require specific permits to be issued for the activities covered by this Agreement, Company shall follow all rules and regulations governing the activities as if permits had been issued by these agencies.

6. **Taxes and Assessments**. A taxable possessory interest may be created by this use and Company may be subject to the payment of property taxes levied on such interest. Company shall pay before delinquent any and all taxes and assessments levied against Company by reason of Company's use and occupancy of the Recreation Area.

7. **Publicity**. Company hereby agrees that Casitas may utilize any publicity generated for, or because of the Tournaments for the mutual and/or separate benefit of Company and/or Casitas at no cost to Casitas. Company agrees that any publicity credits shall include "Lake Casitas Recreation Area" as the location.

8. **Discrimination**. Company agrees that during the use of Casitas Municipal Water District's Recreation Area facilities, no qualified person shall be prevented from participating or denied the benefits of, or otherwise be subjected to discrimination because of the person's race, color, national origin, age or handicap.

9 **Title VI Compliance**. Company hereby acknowledges that as a subrecipient of federal funds, Casitas Municipal Water District's Recreation Area cannot discriminate against anyone on the basis of race, color, natural origin, age or handicap in the provision of its services to the public. Anyone who believes that he/she has been subjected to discrimination can file a complaint either with the Casitas Municipal Water District, 1055 Ventura Avenue, Oak View, CA 93022, or the Office for Equal Opportunity, U.S. Department of the Interior, Washington, D.C. 20240.

10. **Law & Jurisdiction Governing**. This Agreement is being delivered and shall be deemed entered into in the State of California and shall be governed by and construed according to the laws of such state. Any dispute, claim or controversy between the parties shall be arbitrated and/or litigated in Ventura

County, California. If any provision of this Agreement is determined to be illegal, invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions hereof shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect.

11. **Entire Agreement**.

(a) This document constitutes the entire Agreement between Casitas and Company for the use granted at the Lake Casitas Recreation Area for the Tournaments.

(b) This document may be modified only by further written agreement between the parties hereto. Any such modification shall not be effective unless and until executed by Company and in the case of Casitas, except as otherwise specifically authorized herein, until approved and executed by Casitas' Park Services Manager, General Manager and/or Board of Directors.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board of Directors approve Change Order No. 1 for the Robles-Casitas Canal Replacement in the amount of \$16,200.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION:

The Robles-Casitas Canal is a concrete lined channel that delivers water from the Robles Fish Passage Facility to Lake Casitas for storage and future use. The canal panels under the De La Garrigue Bridge are damaged and need to be replaced. A purchase order contract with E.P. Construction has previously been approved by the General Manager and work will commence in early October.

Additional concrete work surfaces are needed at the Robles Fish Passage facility to allow for the easy removal and cleaning of the fish screen diffuser panels. Casitas staff has prepared the site and were originally going to place the concrete. Other priorities have prevented staff from completing the concrete work. By using a separate contractor to complete the work, Casitas staff will be able to focus on other maintenance items at Robles and other pipe line repair work.

EP Construction has submitted a proposal to complete the concrete work at Robles for \$16,200. E.P. Construction's purchase order contract to complete the panel replacement is for \$18,000, bringing the total to \$34,200. The FY 2012-13 Budget allocated \$30,000 in account 11-5-53-5040-13 for this project making this project \$4,200 over budget. The \$16,200 change order is over the maximum 10% change order approval authorization for the General Manager.

Staff is recommending proceeding with the project to make sure this work is completed before the rainy season.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board of Directors approve the purchase order for Consolidated Electrical Distributors in the not to exceed amount of \$153,881.16 for the purchase of electrical motor control centers and associated electrical equipment for the Ojai Valley Pump Plant electrical upgrade project.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION:

The FY 2012/13 budget contains funds in the amount of \$275,000.00 for the purchase, delivery, and installation of the pump/motor control centers and associated equipment for the Ojai Valley Pump Plant electrical upgrade project.

In January 2009 the Board of Directors approved expenditures for an engineering consultant to perform a pump plant-by-pump plant evaluation of seven pumping facilities. The evaluation identified and estimated the costs to provide the necessary materials and actions to bring each plant from the Edison meter to the pump motors up to NEC and NFP 70E standards. The Ojai Valley pump plant was identified as the fourth facility in need of upgrading based on the urgency of electrical safety hazard repairs.

To date, two pump plants were competitively bid with Allen Bradley motor control centers selected in both cases. Motor control centers require both spare parts and specialized employee training. Motor control centers are expensive with an individual unit running from approximately \$50,000 to upwards of \$250,000 depending on the size of the pump motor. Each pump plant requires multiple motor control centers. Allen Bradley motor control centers have worked well with minimal problems.

Allen Bradley sells their equipment through distributors that have exclusive territories. Consolidated Electric Distributors (CED) of Ventura is the local Allen Bradley distributor. Staff recommends that the motor control centers be purchased under sole source designation from Allen Bradley through CED. The District's current program of maintaining a supply of Allen Bradley spare parts allows for the realization of life cycle cost savings and the minimizing of Operation's expense budget requirements.

The purchase order's total amount includes an estimated additional sum of \$1,100.00 for CED to provide shipping FOB job site.

It is recommended that the Board of Directors approve a purchase order for Industrial Coating and Restoration Services in the not to exceed amount of \$ 20,000.00 for the recoating of Casitas Dam intake track from elevation 552.60 to elevation 540.20. This is an unbudgeted maintenance opportunity.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION:

Industrial Coatings and Restoration Services recently completed the recoating of Casitas Dam's control house exterior metal work, work platforms, and intake track down to elevation 552.60. The lake has dropped an additional 13 feet in elevation since the development of the original project's scope. The winter season is fast approaching and a series of average to above average rainfall winters could delay this maintenance for several years. It is important to take advantage of such maintenance opportunities when available.
