Minutes of the Casitas Municipal Water District Board Meeting Held March 9, 2016

A meeting of the Board of Directors was held March 9, 2016 at the District office in Oak View, California. The meeting was called to order at 3:00 p.m. Directors Kaiser, Baggerly, Word, and Bergen were present. Director Hicks was absent. Also present were Steve Wickstrum, General Manager, Rebekah Vieira, Clerk of the Board, and Attorney, John Mathews. There were two staff member and three members of the public in attendance. President Kaiser led the group in the flag salute.

2. General Manager comments.

Mr. Wickstrum informed the board that upon submittal of the offer to Golden State Water Company the District received a public records request for 41 items, some of the records are requested from 2000 and 2005 forward.

3. <u>Board of Director comments.</u>

Director Baggerly informed the board that OBGMA is talking to an attorney in Santa Barbara regarding representation.

4. Board of Director Verbal Reports on Meetings Attended.

Director Bergen reported on her attendance at the Upper Ventura River Basin Groundwater meeting the previous day from 2:00 – 7:00 p.m. They worked on the joint powers agreement and had major discussions regarding the voting process. They decided they would not develop the bylaws at this time but will wait until after the JPA is complete. Director Bergen added that she volunteered to help with the notice of intent.

Director Baggerly suggested that since the residents did not receive the information until Monday and have only had a couple of days to review it and have asked for a postponement it is fair that they be given an opportunity to review and comment substantially. Director Bergen added it was short notice and we can allow more time. Director Baggerly moved that this be postponed until we are notified by the residents that they have completed their sound study. President Kaiser suggested that since the public is here we should hear from them.

Brian Holly thanked Mr. Baggerly for bringing this up and we want more time to look at this. At the last meeting we discussed the frequency issue. Director Baggerly played a recording while Mr. Holly was talking. President Kaiser asked that Director Baggerly turn the recording off. Director Baggerly stated this is the sound they listen to 24/7, get used to it.

Mr. Holly continued stating that high pitch Mr. Baggerly played is on quite frequently especially during the hotter months. The main point is we are not trying to make an issue; we want a resolution to this problem. We want to come to an agreement to a solution. We are open for ideas and request time to consider that option. This report falls short of discussing the frequency issues, it is not comparing apples to oranges. If the skirts did dampen the frequency let's look at those numbers. That recording Mr. Baggerly took is still the loud pitch noise that is there. We want our sound consultant to do a peer review. The Board should also have that information available before making decisions.

Carl Fout then commented that walking outside his house; it was quiet until you walk out front when the pumps are being used. It is very irritating, like an irritating pitch from an old radio station without good reception. It takes away from the whole purpose of living on the east end of Ojai. We live out there for the quiet and to be surrounded by nature. He suggested there may be a bearing issue in the pumps and suggested to shelter the thing with insulating material. He sees other facilities that are shelters with soundproof walls, a tough shed with walls and insulation so it is sound proof. Either a way to solve it or the bearings in the pumps needs to be maintained or removed and replaced.

Lou Preiczer thanked the board for this opportunity to speak and for the cooperative effort to work to resolve this problem amicably. He stated that they got the report two days ago and need more time to review it. He added that he is not here to be a thorn in your side but the pumps are loud and there may be a simple solution to control the frequency. Insulation in walls helps and might insulate the sound. He asked the board to consider our neighborhood that has children hearing this unpleasant sound.

Mr. Wickstrum asked how much time they would need. Mr. Holly thought they would need at least 30 days. President Kaiser asked how much time and money has been devoted to this. Neil Cole said the last time he looked it was approximately \$70,000 - \$80,000. Mr. Word added that having more time will not include more staff time. Mr. Wickstrum added we will coordinate with their consultant. Director Baggerly asked for the high frequency to be addressed as it is not in the study. President Kaiser said the high frequency data is in the report.

Brian Holly said he would like to see if the skirts placed at the bottom of the motor mutes knocked the frequency down. President Kaiser added you have to understand what staff has tried to do to address this sound that has been out there for a great number of years. There are many places throughout the district where there are pumps. In my district, they are 30 feet away from residents. Mr. Holly explained that Charlie has lived there forever and when they built those homes the frequency was not as high. He suggested that it could be that the bearings are wearing out. The noise has gotten louder. When I first started putting letters out there were already three or four letters that pre-dated me. President Kaiser asked if he has copies of those letters. Mr. Holly responded yes.

A requirement of the Code is the allowance of a 15 day notice from the date of mailing to the person whose property is to be acquired by eminent domain, for that person to file a written request to appear and be heard by the Board of Directors. The setting of the hearing for April 13, 2016, would provide the appropriate number of days to comply with the Code requirement.

4. Review of the Financial Statement for December 2015.

The Committee reviewed the financial statement and discussed revenue, expenses, and allocation penalty charges that have been collected to date. The Committee reviewed the status of the budgeted capital projects.

5. Review of the Water Consumption for December 2015.

The Committee reviewed the water consumption numbers for January 2016. There is a notable reduction in water use due to sporadic rainfall events and customer conservation efforts in every classification.

6. <u>Discussion regarding 2016/2017 Budget.</u>

Denise Collin presented the initial work on budget revenue, expenses and capital projects. The estimated water sales decreased for FY 2016-17 that is anticipated from water demand reductions resulting from conservation measures.

7. <u>Discussion regarding Water Rates.</u>

The Committee discussed the initial rate structures that have been developed initially by Raftelis Consultants and slight modifications that consider the removal of two residential tiers. The Committee discussed the applicability of variation in water sales reserves for offsetting the estimated water sales reduction. Additional work to proceed and to be brought to the Committee.

8. Results of the vehicle bid for a 2016 Ford ¾ ton Super Duty 4x4 truck with the lowest bidder being Ventura Ford at a cost of \$26,790.78 as a special order with an approximate 12 week delivery schedule.

The Committee was informed of the bids received for a Ford truck. The item will be moved forward to the Board for consideration of approving the purchase. The Committee was also informed that the remaining budget may be a part of a request at a later date for an electric powered utility vehicle to be used at the Water Treatment Plant.
