GENERAL MANAGER COMMENTS

Mr. Flood reported that the District is moving back to a five day rotational work week on Monday. This will allow customers to call in all five days of the week. The lobby will remain closed as well the board room. We are looking at other possibilities we might need to do as we progress back to a regular schedule such as wearing masks and sanitizing schedules and will continue to modify as needed. RECOMMENDATION:

Award a contract to Matheson Tri-Gas, Inc to provide and deliver liquid oxygen to Casitas Dam for fiscal year 2020-21 in an amount not to exceed \$210,679.00.

BACKGROUND:

Liquid oxygen is used at Casitas Dam to improve water quality. The Lake Hypolimnetic Oxygenation system was installed in 2016 and utilizes between 182,000 and 309,000 gallons of liquid oxygen per year. The current contract with Praxair has a cost of \$0.48 per gallon and expires May 31, 2020. Praxair has indicated their price will then increase to \$1.72 per gallon.

A Notice Inviting Bids to Provide and Deliver Liquid Oxygen to Casitas Dam for FY20-21 was posted to the District's website on April 10, 2020. Two bids were submitted and bids were opened on May 8, 2020. Bid results are shown in Table 1.

A contract was awarded to AirGas at the Board meeting of May 27, 2020 in the amount of \$121,550 based on estimated usage of 286,000 gallons. On June 3, 2020, communication (Attachment 1) was received from AirGas indicating they were retracting their bid and revising their pricing. The bid documents allow the District to award to the next lowest responsive bid, which is Matheson. Matheson has indicated they will honor their bid (Attachment 2).

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The budget for fiscal year 20-21 includes a request of \$165,000. If additional funds are needed during the year, a request will be made.

Date: June 5, 2020

RECOMMENDATION:

The purchase order be approved by the Board of Directors

BACKGROUND:

The Rincon 2M system has suffered numerous leaks over the last four weeks that have caused multiple water service outages for the District's customers on that system (approximately 540 water services).

The most serious of these occurred at Station 37 that involves the transition of a 14" pipeline into and out of a deep canyon.

This particular location was repaired once in June of 2019 and twice just recently during the week of June 1st, 2020.

Casitas staff reports the condition of the pipeline at this location is so poor as to necessitate its immediate replacement.

DISCUSSSION:

District staff conducted several emergency water service shutdowns over the last four weeks on the Rincon 2M system that includes two failures of a portion of the mainline at approximately Station 37 of the District's redline plans.

The condition of the steel of the mainline at this location has corroded to the point where continued repairs will not be feasible and a complete replacement of this section of the Rincon 2M system is necessary.

The methodology to replace this portion of the Rincon 2M mainline involves the installation of a similar sized section of HDPE in parallel with the existing mainline and then tying the HDPE line in at upstream and downstream location of the existing main.

The District has employed these techniques on this system in the past including a similar replacement in the Faria Beach portion of this system (at the Padre Juan crossing) in early 2019.

District staff will be meeting on site with the selected contractor on Monday, June 8th to discuss the details of the replacement and obtain a cost estimate.

A cost estimate will be provided prior to the Board Meeting but is expected to exceed \$100,000.

This Rincon 2M system was put into service in 1960.
